CODE OF PRACTICE FOR ICT USE BY STUDENTS AT EMERSON SCHOOL

Students are not to bring CDs, DVDs, USB and all other mobile devices to school to use on the school system.

Students are not to download unauthorised programs or files.

I agree to allow my child to access the Internet within areas specified that have been previously viewed by the classroom teacher or quality assured and available through Department of Education and Early Childhood Development's web site or other sources approved by the school.

I understand that a member of the school staff can filter all incoming e-mail correspondence before being given to students.

I have explained to my child that he/she should click on the Home button and inform the teacher if he/she encounters any material on the web that makes him/her feel uncomfortable at any time.

My child is aware that he/she should never give out personal information, including their phone number, last name or home address when using the Internet.

My child will be respectful in how they talk to and work with others online and will never write or participate in online bullying.

If my child receives or sends e-mails containing offensive language or inappropriate attachments, he/she will lose his/her e-mailing privileges.

If my child deliberately chooses to access inappropriate web sites he/she will lose <u>all</u> access to the Internet.

Non adherence by students the above conditions will result in the withdrawal of access to all ICT facilities.

I support the conditions for use of the ICT facilities and agree with the consequences above.
