UNIFORM POLICY

All students are expected to wear the Emerson School uniform. The wearing of a uniform installs a sense of pride and belonging. It enhances the safety of students through the early identification of persons not belonging to the school, and management of students in off-campus activities. Uniforms promote equality amongst students through common dress.

The Emerson Uniform

White polo shirt and navy blue shorts or pants.

Male students have the option of wearing grey shorts or pants.

All students have the option of wearing a navy blue jumper or navy blue bomber jacket. Female students have the option of wearing the official school dress in summer and the official school pinafore/skirt in winter.

All students are expected to wear a hat while outside to prevent skin cancers.

Beleza Pty. Ltd. are the official supplier of the uniform. They can be contacted on 955408577. Students are expected to wear safe and appropriate footwear.

Due to safety and hygiene concerns, body piercing, jewellery, tattoos and sleepers are banned, however students can wear a pair of studs in their ears.

Extreme hair colours or haircuts are NOT allowed.

Male students must be clean shaven.

Implementing the Wearing Of School Uniform To School.

The Emerson School Council expects all students will wear correct school uniform. Pastoral teachers will encourage and motivate their students to continue this practice as part of their curriculum and classroom management procedures.

The following procedure will be implemented for students who are not wearing a school uniform:

- 1. A phone call will be made to the parents of the student informing them that it is School Policy for all students to wear their uniform to school. An offer of support will be made to help solve the problem.
- 2. An official letter will be sent, via the Post, explaining that their child is out of uniform and contravening School Policy. This letter will be co-signed by the Principal and President of School Council.

Uniform Assistance Program

When phone calls and letters are sent to parents, every attempt will be made to find a positive solution to ensure students comply with school uniform standards. Where appropriate students will be issued with a compatible shirt or jumper.
