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## PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

Middle Campus

#### ABC Conversation Hour, Thursday 5 May

I was a guest speaker on yesterday's ABC 774 Conversation Hour. This was in response to an article in the Melbourne Age and Sydney Morning Herald suggesting that all Specialist Schools should close and all staff and resources be distributed amongst Government Primary and Secondary schools. I pointed out that the key strength of education in our 'Education State' of Victoria was the options and choices that parents have when choosing a school for their son or daughter.

Emerson specialises in a broad range of intensive learning programs across many forms of literacy and applied learning. Nearly 2900 students have been enrolled at Emerson since we began in 1973. Our greatest advocates are the students, parents, guardians and families who have greatly benefited from our collaborative learning environment.

One of my final comments from the radio interview was that if the unwise decision was made to close Specialist Schools, then you would have to close all accelerated learning and select entry schools also. Another point that I did not mention was that many students in Victoria cannot go to fee paying schools because they cannot afford it.

I am privileged and proud to be part of the Emerson community. I encourage all members of our community to speak openly and enthusiastically about why you chose Emerson. You chose Emerson because it was your right, and the option was there for you to choose. Emerson is more than inclusion. It is an immersion program where students can unlock their potential, have a fuller sense of enjoyment and achievement, and participate as productive citizens of Victoria and Australia.

#### **VALUE OF THE FORTNIGHT**


We will continue studying the value, Thankfulness, next week.
