## KINDNESS AWARDS

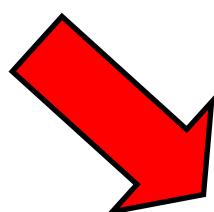
- ◆ Sugi has nominated Jasper M for being so considerate to two boys who were upset in the playground.

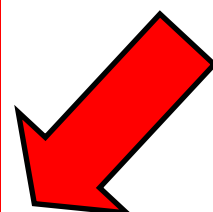
