We will be studying the value, Cleanliness, for the next fortnight.

This Sunday, 5 March, is Clean Up Australia Day. For the past 33 years over 20 million Australians have donated more than 38.5 million hours to improve our environment. The Rubbish Report is a snapshot of the items these volunteers removed from several locations in Australia. Here are some of the statistics:

- 46% of all reported rubbish was found in our waterways -beaches, rivers and dive sites.
- ♦ 14% was found in parks
- ♦ 13% in bushlands
- plastic litter dominated all locations with 79% of it found in school grounds.
