# **Victorian All Schools Championships**

Over two weekends in October and November, six Middle and Senior students participated in the Victorian All Schools Championships.

This competition featured the best athletes from both independent and government schools across the state. As a team we collected 3 x Gold and 7 x Bronze medals:

- Kai F (SSS) 2 x Bronze (shot put, 100m)

- Eddie A (MSI) 2 x Bronze (100m, 200m)


Many students achieved personal bests:
