SCHOOL SAVING BONUS INFORMATION

Dear parents and carers,

As shared with you previously, parents and carers of every child enrolled in a Victorian government school in 2025 will receive the one-off School Saving Bonus \$400 support.

In the coming months, the Department of Education will send you 2 email communications for each of your children enrolled in Victorian government schools.

By Friday 18 October 2024, please ensure that your child's 2025 enrolment is completed and that your contact information is up to date.

The 2 emails from the Department of Education will:

- Confirm your email address between mid-October and late-November.
- Provide you with your unique \$400 School Saving Bonus code by the end of November.

If you do not receive a confirmation email from the department by late-November, please check your spam or junk folders and contact our office on 9791 8900 if needed.

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JUNIOR SCHOOL NEWS—TERM 4 NO HAT, NO PLAY

A reminder that all students (and staff!) are required to wear a sun-safe hat (preferably navy blue) whilst outside during Term 4 and Term 1. This includes playtimes, physical education classes and school excursions.

Most of our Junior School students are wearing their sun-safe hats outside as you can see in the photos. If a student is not wearing a hat outside they will be asked to sit an undercover area.

Types of sun-safe hats include:

Broad-brimmed hat: The brim should be proportional to the size of the child's head and provide shade for the whole face.











Bucket hat: Bucket or surfer-style hats should have a deep crown and sit low on the head. It should shade the face, ears and back of the neck.











Legionnaire-style hat: Legionnaire-style hats should have a flap that covers the neck. The side flap and front peak (brim) should meet to protect the sides of the face.











Please Note: Baseball caps and sun visors do not protect the cheeks, ears and back of the neck and are not recommended.


CASUAL DRESS DAY
