As soon as they had finished their final exams, they enlisted to serve in World War I in the Medical Corps. Their names were: Alan Couve, Eric Bisset, Wallace Jewkes and Malcom Jones.

They all died in the war and never came back to graduate at the College of Pharmacy in Parkville. This college is now part of Monash University. Over 100 years later, the University decided that these young men should have a Graduation. None of the deceased pharmacists had any children. Therefore, distant relatives accepted the Graduation Certificates on behalf of their deceased Great Uncles.

I will be remembering these brave young Pharmacists tomorrow, along with all other women and men that served our country.

Lest We Forget.



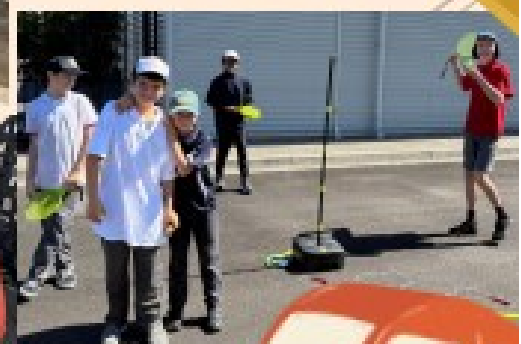
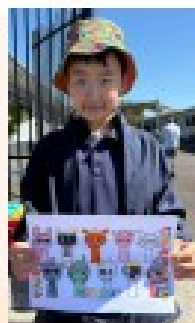
