I would like to welcome all students, staff and families back to Term 3. It is wonderful to see so many happy and smiling students' faces sharing stories about their holidays.



## What is Compass?


Compass is a school management solution that allows parents and carers to access up-to-date and meaningful information about your school and your child's progress.

Compass includes many different features, including the ability to:

- Monitor your child's attendance, and enter an explanation for absence or lateness
- Communicate with your child's teachers, and update your family contact details
- View your child's timetable and the school calendar
- Monitor your child's homework and assessment tasks
- Download and view your child's academic reports
- Book parent-teacher conferences
- Pay and provide consent for events and school fees

Emerson will advise parents if and when each of these features become available for parent use.







## How do I access Compass?

#### Compass Apps

You can download the Compass App on iOS and Android devices, simply search for Compass School Manager in the store.

To log in you will require your unique family username and password. These details will be provided to you by our school on a date to be confirmed in Term 3.
