PRINCIPAL'S REPORT


We are currently preparing for a three day School Review that will evaluate student learning and wellbeing over the four year period of 2021 – 2024. This process will involve a Reviewer from Monash University, two external School Principals, and our Senior Education Improvement Leader (SEIL) from our Regional Office of the Department of Education.

Over the last 25 years, we have been involved in an enormous expansion of our learning programs and the recruitment of highly skilled staff. The aim of these developments is to unlock the potential of all students. The completion of Stage One and Two of our Building Modernization program in 2023 and 2025 has provided our students and staff with spacious and specialized facilities that our students and staff need and deserve.

The forthcoming review will provide us with the impetus to continue and complete our modernization program.

A big thank-you to all staff for their amazing support — from coaching and umpiring to organising and cheering on our teams each week.




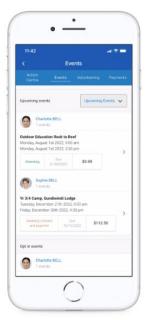


Compass for Parents has launched.
