We have had much to celebrate in 2025, including the opening of our Emerson Technology Centre and the launch of the Emerson documentary; both significant milestones for our school community.


I wish all families a safe and happy Christmas. Enjoy the holiday season, and we look forward to welcoming all students back on Wednesday, 28 January 2026.
